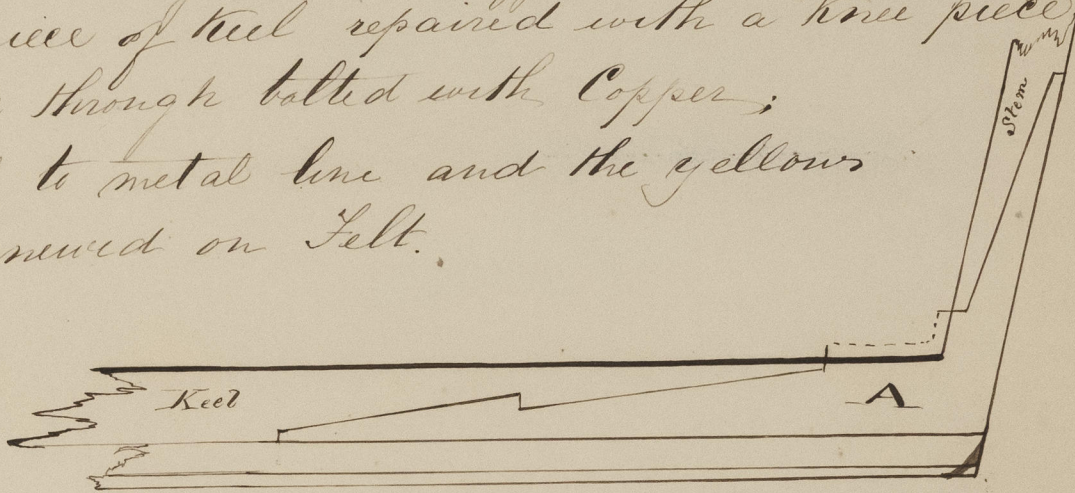

Yellow metal sheathing stripped off. The lower piece of stem and fore piece of keel repaired with a piece of English Oak well through bolted with Copper; recaulked from keel to metal line and the yellow metal sheathing renewed on felt.
