REPAIRS

At this date split out the Strake of Deck next the Waterway nearly all fore and aft on both sides. (the Beam ends proved sound and good.) Renew'd it with Yellow Pine (4 ins), caulked the same, and as far as practicable overhauled her inside and outside. It being a change of property recommended that the Chain Cables should be got up and ranged on deck; which has been done, and they proved sufficient in size and length (as Per Rule,) and apparently good in quality.
