REPAIRS

At this date Stripped off the whole of the Yellow Metal and wood Sheathing. Condemned the after length of Keel a part of the Stem and a good portion of the outside planking (both sides) found badly worm'd and as reported on the 29th ult. —

Renewed the after length of Keel (26 ft 14 ins by 9¹/₂) Red Pine.
 New Stem piece 8 ft 9¹/₂ by 11 Danish Oak. —

Seventeen planks in the bottom Starboard side of Red Pine. and Danish Oak four lengths in the Wales. —

Eighteen on the Port side and three lengths in the Wales. —

Caulk'd from Keel to Gunwale and gave her a good overhaul. —
