Stripped off the whole of the Yellow metal Sheathing.  
 Condemned the whole of the Keelson except the after length.  
 Introduced a New Keelson of East India Seal 13ins by 15ins -  
 fastened with iron bolts.

A New length of Lumber Strake Port side of Eng<sup>d</sup> hull  
 Hung her in Shores. Caulked from the Keel to a Seam  
 above the Wales. Resheathed with Yellow metal on  
 felt up to 14ft marks, and gave her a good overhaul.
