REPAIRS

faulked from keel to gunwale with deck, sheathed bottom with 1 1/4 in. fir over felt and with Yellow metal on felt. Renewed lower bolts of Riggers with Yellow metal, also part chain bolts of Iron. Put on a deck house strongly secured with Iron knees.
