REPAIRS of Damage

The Quarter Galleries taken off and the quarter shut in with plank, and the poop berthing repaired -
 The following renewed viz. All the Main and topgallant bulwarks and all the Roughtree stanchions from the poop to the forecastle on both sides - the stanchions with Eng Oak - 180 feet of Main deck with Yellow pine -
 On the Port side 54 ft of covering board with Teak. 40 ft of Roughtree rail - 82 ft of outside rail 8 1/2 x 4 and the whole of the pin rail -
 On the Starboard side 25 ft of covering board with Teak & the gallows bitt and cross piece - a new tiller fitted and the Vessel faulted from the fore part of the fore chains aft - from the wales to the covering board and the whole of the upper deck -
