REPAIRS now done, viz: -

The Yellow Metal Sheathing stripped off the bottom, the keel hung in shrou fore and aft, recaulked from keel to metal line, and her bottom resheathed with Yellow Metal on felt.

She has now been supplied with one of Rogers Iron Stocked Anchors; weight 12^{cwt} 0^{qrs} 0^{lbs} Proof strain applied 13^{cwt} 18^{qrs} and tested at the Society's Proving House Poplar. 14th Oct. 1864 J.S.
