REPAIRS Now done, The whole of her Metal Sheathing stripped, Bottom examined and part of upper deck between the Fore and Main Stitches removed.

Renewed, 13 planks of upper deck with Yellow Pine between the Fore and Main Stitches; Caulked from the keel to the 6th Streak of Deck, and her Bottom Sheathed with Yellow Metal on Felt up to the 20 ft Mark; Also an additional pair of Staple Knees fitted to the After Beam.
