REPAIRS

Now done, the yellow metal sheathing stripped off the bottom and renewed upon felt, the keel caulked throughout - Her upper deck shelf additionally through bolted with inch Galvanized Iron, the sides additionally bolted with 7/8 Galvanized Iron thro bolts in the timbers near the butts - the three upper strakes of outside planking edge bolted with 7/8 Galvanized Iron passing thro the plank sheers - and the upper deck beam ends additionally bolted with 7/8 inch Galvanized Iron bolts passing from the waterway thro the shelf - Several trenails driven out for examination and found good,
