REPAIRS now done:

The Yellow Metal sheathing stripped; one pair of diagonals, Iron Riders added at the after end of the vessel, extending from the Lower deck spirtetting to the Floorheads; the vessel re-caulked from Keel to Metal-line, and re-sheathed with yellow Metal over Felt.
