REPAIRS Now done, consequent upon damage, The yellow metal sheathing stripped off - the Vessel hung in shores and caulked from the keel to the plank sheer - and the bottom resheathed with Yellow metal on felt -

The following not consequent upon damage - Retenailed from Plank sheer to lower part of bilges with locust and English Oak - the lower piece of apron renewed with Eng Oak - three breast hooks taken down and refastened in way of apron - the bolts of riders examined and the broken ones renewed with Yellow metal - and the Waterway seam and the two next caulked.
