REPAIRS

At this date stripped off the whole of the Yellow Metal Sheathing; Caulked the outside from Keel to Gunwale, including also the deck, waterway seams, Scarphs of Keel &c. - Renew'd some of the bolts in the Rudder bands (found loose.) a throat bolt, in one of the Hold beam Rider knees, Resheathed with Yellow metal on felt. - Removed or set aside "Cunninghams Patent" fitted her with double topsail Yards, New main Yard, and new jibboom introduced

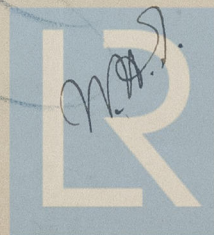
