## REPAIRS

Caulked up to the Deck, Boot topped with 1 1/4 pine on felt. from nearly the upper part of Wales to 8 ft 9 in down. Sheathed with Yellow metal on felt up to 16 feet. Changed the two upper braces Pistles & which were of iron, for Yellow metal. better secured the Hawse pipes. —
