Introduced seven new bulwark stanchions on the Port side, and part new Roughtree rail in mid's. with some bulwark berthing, two new cleek beams (aft side of main hatchway), two new Stern timbers, new quarter pieces. Counter Planks all new, shortened the head of Yudder. Renewed several lengths of deck planks. Caulked and repaired the cleek. — and put all in order. —
