On Port side Renewed lathead of English Oak, nine lengths of deck to forecastle of Lantzie Pine, chock, forecastle of American Elm forecastle lining of Lantzie Pine, about two dozen treenails of English Oak, head rails and timbers; — repaired chain plates and fore channel and iron stanchions to forecastle; introduced nine filling between timbers to forecastle of English Oak; caulked from after part of fore chains forward from metal line to waterways with forecastle drifts and deck and main deck from windlass forward
