REPAIRS

from damage having been struck by some heavy seas in Dec<sup>r</sup> lash. — ten bulwark stanchions renew'd on the Port side thirteen on the Starb<sup>d</sup>, together with about three fourths of the bulwark berthing from stem to gangways both sides. Rough tree rail. topgall't bulwark &c, all put in order, repaired, and made good. — lifted the limbers. examined the Keelson. sighted the yellow metal and found it generally good. — Caulked from copper line to Gunw all round the bulwark stanchions &c.
