REPAIRS None done:-

Yellow-metal sheathing stripped off the Bottom, and caulked from keel to the metal-line. Resheathed the Bottom with Yellow-metal on felt.

Limbers lifted, Floors examined and found good. The salt-casing removed from the Keelson, in several places; where thus exposed, the Keelson proved to be in good condition.

A Bill for a new English oak Windlass, dated Liverpool, 22<sup>nd</sup> December 1864, having been produced; the Wood-linings were not stripped at this time.

Renewed the Lower Mast and Bowsprit with Yellow-pine, and the foremast piece of Kalse-keel with American Elm.
