Now done:- At the request of the owners I inspected this vessel and found that the Foremast, Main-mast, and Rousprit has been renewed with Yellow-pine, and the Lib. boom with American Fir. The whole of the Lards, except the two upper Topsail Yards, -renewed with Redpine. A suit of new Sails now supplied. The whole of the standing and running rigging new.

Bills, dated Mauritius, November 184, showing that, this vessels' Bottom was Yellow-metalled or felt at that date, - have been produced. The owners are desirous that this should be noted in the Registry Book.
