## REPAIRS

Bills, shewing that this vessel was remodelled as felt at Shanghai, in November 1854, have been produced. The Owners request that this may be noted in the Register Book.

Now done:- Windlass unhooking, the Hood-linings stripped and the Main-piece examined and found good.

This vessel was partly loaded for sea, consequently her middle-line and spears could not be examined.
