The yellow metal sheathing stripped, the ship caulked from keel to metal line, the butts of Wales, Topsides, and the whole of the Buttocks, and Counter, also the waterway seams, and resheathed the bottom with yellow metal on paper

Renewed the third Bower Anchor tested at "Lloyds" proving house Poplar as per Certificate No 1836 strain applied equal 16 Tons. 3 Cwt. weighing 14 cwt. 2 qrs 20 lbs ex stock

Repaired the Boats, and Fished the main mast and secured with eight iron hoops.
