REPAIRS

Now done: Yellow-metal sheathing stripped off the Bottom, and caulked from Keel to Plank-sheer. Resheathed the Bottom with Yellow-metal or brown-paper.

Middle-line cleared, timbers lifted, on both sides, fore and aft; and the Keelson, Floors, Stemson, and Stems, where seen, were found in a satisfactory condition. Windlass running, the wood-linings stripped and the Main-piece condemned.

Renewed the Main-piece of Windlass with English oak.
