REPAIRS

Stripped Yellow metal sheathing, scraped bright from light mark to waterways, drove out bolts and trenails as per Rule Sec. 54, 1st pt took out a listing at each end of vessel equal to one fifth of her length; windlass unhooking, stripped, examined and found good chains ranged on deck examined & found good & sufficient.

faulked from keel to waterways and re-sheathed with yellow metal over paper.

The timbers of the frame where exposed were in a satisfactory condition.

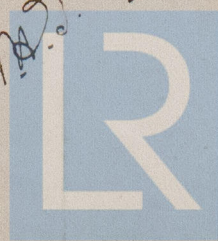
