Took out a plank in each buttock for the examination of the timbers of the frame which proved in a satisfactory condition; renewed these planks with Pitch Pine

It appears from the report of survey No. 26130, London, that this vessel underwent the whole of the requirements of the Rules for Red A, second survey <sup>in 1864</sup> with the exception of the removal of the buttock planks which have now been taken out for the examination of the timbers, see owners letter to Committee with reply. 22<sup>nd</sup> Dec 1866
