**REPAIRS**

Now done:- The Yellow metal sheathing stripped off the Bottom, and the Vessel caulked from the Keel to the Plank sheer. Resheathed the Bottom with Yellow metal over felt.

Added a Kider. Keelson of Oak, 14x9, ranging from a shift the fore side of the Foremast, to the Mizzen Mast step, and bolted it through the Main Keelson, 4 loors, and about one-third through the Keel with galvanized Iron bolts.

Lifted the Limbers on each side, fore and aft, the 4 loors examined and found good.

Renewed the Sternson. Knee with English Oak, and well bolted it through the Keel and Sternpost, also, through and through, from side to side.
