REPAIRS now done. The yellow metal stripped; hung in shores and caulked from keel to the top of wales, and the bottom resheathed with yellow metal upon felt; the head knee repaired; the windlass new of English Oak fitted with a through spindle, 4 in square; the waterway seam and the next seam of deck, of each deck caulked. The middle line and peaks cleared, and the lumber boards lifted; the keelson floors &c examined and found to be in good condition.
