REPAIRS Now done, Peaks cleared and timbers lifted all fore and aft, Keelson and floors examined and found good; Windlafs (of Iron) overhauled and repaired,

Sighted bottom Yellow metal stripped, Ship hung in Shores and caulked from keel to metal line, part of topsides, stanchions, bulwarks of deck, round coamings, also the Waterway Beams &c.

The Owner submitted the ship to the above Survey in preference to the new Rule for Half time Survey.

Added one Bower Anchor 20. 2. 21 tested to 27. 12. 1. 7 at the Staffordshire P. C. and at test to as Certificate No 2036 March 16<sup>th</sup> 1866 Signed S. Trezona.

Wings lumbered with ballast and dunnage &c.
