The bottom sighted and the Yellow Metal patched, about fifteen feet of false renewed amidships - faulted from the Yellow Metal to gunwale; the main deck caulked; one iron breast-hook and two iron pointers aft, added, bolted with galvanized iron nut & screw bolts - the buttock planks additionally fastened with galvanized iron nut & screw bolts - the head rails and timbers and iron bobstay plate renewed; new main and mizen topmasts -
