Sighted bottom the Yellow Metal stripped; Caulked from keel to the upper part of wales, round the stanchions, and part of deck; lead listed the keel seams, also the fore and after hood ends, and resheathed the bottom with yellow metal on felt.

Renewed the Fore Yard, also the Fore-top-sail Yard, with Red-pine.
