Now done:- The Bottom sighted, the Yellow metal sheathing extensively patched, and painted with Peacock's Patent Paint. The caulking of the Bottom tested in places, and found satisfactory. Added a Wood-crutch under the upper deck forward - and well through bolted it. Strengthened the break of the quarter-deck; and also the scarps of Main Rail in way of the said deck. The Mizzen-mast new of Red pine. The flat of Main-deck and the Topsides, from the metal-line upwards, - caulked.

The owner was desirous of continuing the Bottom at this time, but, thinking he could get another short Voyage out of the Yellow metal sheathing, he withdrew the order for the said Survey.
