The hold cleared, stages made inside and outside, treenails and bolts driven out, listings & limbers cleared, a portion of the topside planking scraped, the windlass mihung and stripped, the chains ranged, found good and sufficient, and all other requirements of the Half Time Survey Rule attended to -

The bottom caulked and resheathed with Yellow Metal upon Felt, the main piece of windlass renewed with English Oak -

The lower deck beams and shelf additionally bolted - and the Ceiling repaired
