The bottom caulked and resheathed with Yellow Metal upon Felt - fifteen galvanized iron nuts & screw bolts taken out, both under and just above the cement, all proved to be in good condition; four galv iron keel bolts driven out and found to be a little wasted at the points - the timbers lifted and the cement found to be satisfactory - the four keel bolts renewed with Yellow Metal and the fifteen plank fastenings with galvanized iron -
