Survey'd her in ballast.

Now done patch'd and repaired the yellow metal throughout, caulked from the yellow metal to the gunwale and two seams of the deck next the binding strake. (According to report this vessel has been three times metalld since Jan'y 1864.)

Split out the strake of deck next the waterway on account of the seams being open below, caulking hanging below its work.

Renew'd the strake of deck next the binding strake or waterway both sides the ship all fore and aft, with pitchpine. - the beam ends as far as seen proved sound. - lifted most of the timber boards and cleared the keelson. -
