REPAIRS now done, The yellow metal sheathing stripped off the bottom, and in accordance with the Half-time Survey Sec 34. all listings and the limbers cleared, listings cut at the ends of the hold for one fifth her length. stages made inside and outside, treenails driven out, windlass unhooking and stripped, the cables ranged, examined found good and sufficient, portion of the topsides scraped and all other requirements of the Rule attended to -

fauled throughout and the bottom resheathed with yellow metal upon felt -
