REPAIRS now done,

The timbers and air courses cleared, stages made inside and outside, treenails and bolts drivers out, a portion of the topsides scraped bright, the windlass unhung and examined, the main piece is not covered, the chains ranged and examined, found good and sufficient - and all other requirements of the Half time survey Sec 34 fully complied with - the salt casing of the keelson partly removed the keelson examined and resalted - one iron hook and two iron crutches taken out rewelded and refitted and bolted, caulked from keel to wood sheathing and the bottom resheathed with Yellow Metal upon felt -
