 If Surveyed Afloat or in Dry Dock Green's Lower dock and East India dock.

Last Survey, No. 28408 Port London. Classed Rest 63-7.A.1.

REPAIRS Done: The Bottom sighted and the yellow-metal sheathing  
 hatched and painted with Peacock's paint. The Foremast  
 renewed with Red pine.

Her Windlass, being of Iron, is not reported to have undergone the  
 half-period examination - which it would have been submitted to had  
 been a Wooden one: And seeing that she has not got the  
 fittings required by Section 37. I therefore, deemed it to be my duty  
 to recommend that, she be not submitted to the next Half-time Survey  
 - as per Section 34; and wrote Mr. Green a letter to that effect  
 copy annexed, - which he has declined to comply with.  
 The Hold was lumbered with Ballast.
