The timbers and all an courses cleared, The outside plank scraped in three places on each side from Yellow Metal to Coveringboard, and 12 Turnails backed out on each side, Windlap unhung and stripped, and the Chains ranged on deck, The caulking of the bottom tested by the removal of a few sheets of Yellow Metal, and now supplied with "Dry"
