REPAIRS

Holds cleared proper stages made both inside and outside. The timbers and all air courses cleared, outside planking scraped bright in various parts, bolts and treenails driven out as per Rule, windlass unhung wood linings stripped and chain cables ranged on deck for examination.

Listings have now been cut in the fore and after holds as per Section 34.

Stripped Yellow Metal sheathing, iron thro' fastenings of Hold. Beam knees found rotten and renewed of Yellow Metal deck brace repaired. Caulked from keel to metal line, stanchions covering boards, waterway beams and three beams of deck next them. Bottom sheathed with Yellow Metal on felt.
