et. Cont'd by 9th June 68
 Hold cleared proper stages made both inside and outside. The timbers and all air courses cleared outside planking scraped bright in various parts; keennails driven out as per rule Windlass unhung. Wood linings stripped and chain cables ranged on deck for examination.

Keelings have now been cut in the fore and after ends as per section 34.

Stripped Yellow Metal sheathing; Stemson knee-renewed of English Oak; one Hold beam scarped of Iron Bark and one iron breasthook repaired. Main-piece of Rudder new of English Oak and Step to Fore Mast of Iron Bark all pintles and braces retolled with Copper. Caulked from keel to waterway and re-sheathed bottom with Yellow Metal on Main and Mizzen Masts new of Pine.
