## REPAIRS, &amp;c.

Now done according to the Half Time Survey Rule Section III - The vessel placed in Dry Dock. Treenails driven out for Survey. The Air Courses, and the timbers cleared proper stages made inside and out. The Chain Cables ranged & examined - good and sufficient. The Windlass unhooked and examined - in good condition. The Topsides and Sheerstrakes scraped bright. Examined and found satisfactory. Twelve Knee Rider bolts, of yellow metal, renewed. The Rudder reduced in size. The Deck House and ten Planks of upper deck renewed. The Main Topsides and Sheerstrakes Partially Caulked. The Main Deck and Forecastle Deck Caulked. Her frame, planking, Keelson, Beams, Deck &c are all in very good condition.
