REPAIRS

Condemned the main and Rider Keelson which were found in a state of decay, except the after lengths. - Introduced three new lengths of Pitch pine 15ins by 14ins from 30 to 33 feet in length, bolted the whole with yellow metal of size larger than the original bolts. - Testep'd the main Mast, also the foremast.

Stripped off the whole of the yellow metal sheathing.
Caulked from keel to gunwale, and resheathed with Yellow metal on belt up to the height of about 14 ft. -

N.B. Sundry repairs it would appear she has had abroad (Simons Bay) from Collision, - and sundry at home, or which have been completed here. Viz New support to Starb. Cathard, Head rails repaired, Clamp to heel of jibboom, New face piece to Stem. - Putting on new wire foretopmast stays, and foretopgall stay of wire. - jibguys &c. &c. New foretopsail and New foretopgall sail. - New running gear. -
