REPAIRS

Stripped off the whole of the Yellow metal sheathing
 dubbed the outside planking bright, down to light marks.
 Drifted out treenails, from every alternate frame on fourth timber
 Cut out listings all fore and aft, both sides in the ceiling just above the
 floor heads. — Caulked from Keel to Gunwale and resheathed with
 Yellow metal on felt. (the foregoing has been done in anticipation of
 the Rules (2nd) for Continuation, on her return)

Repaired the Pumps. Gave her a New Windlass. ^{Iron bar —}
 Lifted the Limbs, opened air courses. The limbs at the treenail holes.
 Air courses &c where seen, proved sound and good. — Scraped the
 planks bright inside. — Caulked from Keel to Gunwale and resheathed
 with Yellow metal on felt.
