*I respectfully draw the Committee's attention to the fact of this ship not having been seen by me when in the graving dock above-named. And I beg to state, that no request was made for the Survey, and my being very much pressed with work in all other parts of the District, unfortunately caused this omission, which I much regret, and trust, that the Committee will not attribute what has occurred to negligence on my part.*
