Holds cleared proper stages made both inside and outside. The timbers and all air courses cleared outside planking scraped bright in various parts. Treennails driven out as per Rule. Windlass in hand, wood linings stripped, and chain cables ranged on deck for examination.

Distings have now been cut in the fore and after Holds as per Section 37. - Stripped Yellow Metal Sheathing; two lower cant timbers on Port Bow renewed of oak; and four short fore woods of oak; in way of same, of oak and Baltic oak. Caulked from keel to gunwale and resheathed bottom with Yellow Metal Paint.
