REPAIRS, &c.

Knee of Head Extra thro'fastened, rails and timbers to same renewed, and the Cellor Metal Sheathing on bottom patched.

The Cellor Metal Sheathing was stripped, the vessel caulked from keel to waterway-seam, and the bottom re-sheathed with Cellor Metal on Mill at the Mauritius in April last. The Bills for which have now been produced and found to be satisfactory.

"Although no Record has been made on any of the 'Reports of Survey' in reference to the unhooking and stripping of the 'Windlass' yet the Owners' representative Capt. Jackson declares such was done on one of the Surveys hitherto held, and that the requirements for the Half Year Survey (as that name recog- nized) were attended to."
