REPAIRS, &c. Stripped off the yellow metal. Lified the Bowsprit and repaired it. Took down the Cutwater or Knee of the Head (reported to have been struck by a sea). Unbolted or took out the Stem found split at the upper part. and Apron piece defective the Starb<sup>d</sup> Knighthead. Introduced a new upper length of Stem. Apron, & Starb<sup>d</sup> Knighthead all of Teak. Scarphed the heel and holed the head of Bowsprit. Made good the Knee of the head, and all in connection with it. a new iron breasthook, two decks. and an extra brace, or hook, outside, from Cashead, to Cashead. and some tie bolts put in from side to side. — Caulked from keel to Gunwale, Waterway and two strakes of Deck Resheathed with yellow metal on felt. —
