Stripped off the whole of the yellow metal sheathing.  
 Drifted out some of the iron bolts, from the planks in the bottom, about a dozen from each side, and from various places, and found the samples but slightly affected, by galvanic action. — Cleared away the Cement from the keel bolts, drifted them out, 96 in all. Renewed the same with yellow metal 1 3/8 put them through and clenched them on the false keel. — — Repaired the Wood sheathing. Caulked from keel to gunwale. and resheathed with yellow metal on paper. —
