REPAIRS

Yellow metal sheathing stripped off, scraped bright from waterway, seam to light water mark, trenails and bolts driven out as per Rule; listins cut out in the hold and the frame found good; the hold cleared, timbers lifted, Chains ranged mindless stripped and all other requirements of the Rules fully complied with —

Recaulked from keel to plank sheers and resheathed with yellow metal on Felt.
