REPAIRS, &c.

No Damage.

Upper piece of stem renewed of oak, thro' fastened with Yellow Metal bolts. Knee of head head-rails together with a portion of the head-gear new. Caulked from metal line over all, and supplied new Ropes of Yellow-Pine.

No for Damage Stripped Yellow Metal sheathing, renewed several of the Yellow Metal thro' fastenings of Kolo Beam knee-ribs with Yellow Metal. Extra fastened ceiling in lower-hold with short iron bolts. Rudder-braces taken off, hooding ends in way of same caulked. Caulked from keel to metal line, and resheathed bottom with Yellow Metal on felt.
