## REPAIRS, &c.

The upper part of the knight heads cut off and two large chocks worked over them, connected from side to side by a large iron hook over the bowsprit.

Yellow metal sheathing stripped off recaulked from steel to metal lining and the yellow metal sheathing renewed on felt.
