REPAIRS, &c.

"For Damage" Stripped Yellow Metal sheathing hung in shores and removed the three fore lengths of false keel (about thirty three ft. l. for the purpose of examining the three fastenings of the new fore piece of main keel recently put in at Whampoa; Extra fastened Starb. fore hook of garboard (also new) with Yellow Metal bolts faulked from keel to top of wales and resheathed bottom with Yellow Metal on Sell.

The "Half Yearly Survey" was held at this Port in April 1876. Report No. 275941
 H. B. Sell & Co placed under the "Six Upper-Courses only for damage."
